



Pareidolia is the phenomenon of observing familiar shapes or patterns in random objects. In common parlance, it's also known as Faces in Things.

What case of pareidolia was created by the makers of X using long-cast shadows in the undulating hills, which fits very finely into the theme (and title) of the film?








In which film would you find this mother/son duo?















"The Cut 1", "The Cut 2" and "The Final Cut" are a series of three murals with which Italian artist Alexsandro Palombo took a stand against the dictatorship and the horrors perpetrated by Y. In the work "The Cut 1" X cut her hair in front of the Y Consulate in Milan in memory of \_\_\_\_ and to celebrate the courage of the people of Y; the mural artwork was removed in less than 24 hours. The artist retorted by creating "The Cut 2" with X showing a raised middle finger. In the last mural artwork entitled "The Final Cut", X reappears with Z's head in her hand, a symbolic work that wants to be a hymn to freedom and an encouragement to resistance. Name X and Y/Z.

This very specific tradition was unheard of in the 1990s, before Sachin Tendulkar brought it about to the Indian cricket team. Tendulkar ran into controversy for it in 2005, with the Department of Home Affairs citing the practice as illegal after the BCCI had sought written clarification from the Sports Ministry. Despite the government's directive, Tendulkar received widespread support from several quarters, saying he was doing nothing wrong. This practice later became more commonplace in the Indian team and is followed by almost all the players now.
