

Winning a medal at the Olympics is a dream come true for any athlete. Though gold, silver, and bronze medals get all of the glory, there's another Olympic award that's even harder to come by.

The Pierre de Coubertin medal, named after the founder of the modern Olympics. Unlike the sporting medals, the de Coubertin medal isn't awarded at every cycle of the Games — it's only handed out when the International Olympic Committee deems fit. This medal may be given to athletes, former athletes, sports promoters or sporting officials.

In 1999, ESPN listed him 35th of the 100 greatest North American athletes of the 20th century. At age two, X finished fourth in his 1972 debut in a maiden race, but then won seven of his remaining eight starts.

At the beginning of his three-year-old year, X was syndicated for a record-breaking \$6.08 million (equivalent to \$35 million in 2019), on the condition that he be retired from racing by the end of the year. He is recognized as one of the greatest in his field.

The Indian Cricket League was a private cricket league funded by X (company) that operated between 2007 and 2009 in India. The BCCI refused to recognise the ICL as a cricket league, and criticised Kiran More and Kapil Dev for joining the ICL. Kapil Dev's association with ICL was seen by the establishment as a conflict of interest as he was also the chairman of National Cricket Academy, a BCCI owned cricket facility. On 21 August 2007 Kapil Dev was sacked from his NCA post.

In 2008, following the ICL tradition, BCCI launched Indian Premier League, which killed the existence of ICL.

Organised by Jaypee sports International Itd, the Grand Prix was a race in the Formula One calendar from 2011 to 2013. Even though the organisers had a 5 year contract with F1 management, the grand prix was ruled out of F1 calendar due to tax disputes with the local government. The GP, which was won by the same driver all three times, was held at 'X' circuit, the only grade 1 circuit in the host country.


